Instructor Position

The University of South Alabama Department of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) invites applications for a non-tenure track, twelve-month, Instructor of Emergency Medical Services. Candidates for this position will be expected to advise students and teach EMT, AEMT, and paramedic courses.

Qualifications: Candidates must have a Bachelor's Degree from a regionally accredited institution (Master's Degree preferred), current State of Alabama paramedic license, National Registry paramedic certification a minimum of three years of paramedic work experience, and at least one year of experience as an EMS instructor.

Candidates with a Bachelor's degree will be required to obtain a Master's degree in a related discipline from a regionally-accredited institution within four years of hire date. Candidates must obtain instructor certifications in American Heart Association ACLS, PALS, and BLS within six months of starting position. **Position will start January 1, 2026.**

Review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled.
